While certain journals have longer publication schedules, and there can be unforeseen delays, there are several things you can do as an author to expedite the process.

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Note: Do not import the Figures into the text file. If you use LaTeX to write your articles, we have separate **LaTeX instructions**.

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8. Recheck your chosen journal's Guide to Authors to ensure proper formatting and preparation of your submission.

In the end, your preparation beforehand will save much time and many delays in the publishing process.

9. Submit your manuscript

For initial submission of your paper for review most journals will still accept a printed copy. Please see the individual Guide for Authors for further information.

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
